- (ii) a parade and service be provided on 15th March 2014 to mark the conference and that the Town Mayor present the Association with a suitable scroll to mark and commemorate the occasion.

The Secretary of the Falmouth Royal Naval Association addressed the Council and thanked it on behalf of all his shipmates for the honour and privilege of the award. He added that to his knowledge the Falmouth Branch of the Association was the only Branch in the United Kingdom to receive such recognition.
