P3900 APOLOGIES

P3906 HIGHWAYS/TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT/ROAD SAFETY

Road Closure dated 6th to 7th January 2010 (1900 – 0700hrs) prohibiting traffic on Brook Street between No 6 Berkeley Vale and junction of Killigrew street for the purpose of manhole cover repair works.

Road Closure dated 11th to 13th January 2010 (0730 – 1800hrs) prohibiting through traffic on Bosmeor Road for its entire length for the purpose of patching works.
