P4917 PRE-CONSULTATION FOR A PROPOSED UPGRADE TO AN EXISTING SITE AT FALMOUTH MARINE COLLEGE, KILLIGREW STREET, FALMOUTH

Members duly considered consultation for Vodafone Limited to upgrade radio base station at Falmouth Marine College to provide new 3G/4G coverage in the area with the removal of 3 Vodafone antennas and 3 Telefonica antennas and replacement with 6 antennas for the shared use of Vodafone and Telefonica.

It was resolved to support the proposals as the upgrade will improve connectivity throughout the town.
