## LSC169 <u>CORNWALL COUNCIL NEW LICENCE</u>

(1) New Application for Entertainment/Late Night Refreshments/Alcohol at Pendennis Castle The applicants advised that the licence application sought 5 events, although likely to be only 3 at Pendennis Castle, on Sunday Bank Holidays including plays, films and live music and recorded music until 0100hours. Including late night refreshment and alcohol until 0130 hours. They had worked with the Police Licensing Officer and Environmental Health Officer to devise the application. They responded to Member questions regarding security, policing and site and noise management.

The Chair reported the observations of the Police Licensing Officer.

It was proposed by Councillor Body, seconded by Councillor Mrs Brock and

RESOLVED that the Council supports the license application for a maximum of five events (but notes there there will only be three) subject to conditions that the sales of alcohol ceases at 0030 with a drinking up period to 0100, that the requirements of the Police Licensing Officer including the applicants meeting additional policing costs be adhered to and that the requirements of the Environmental Health Officer in regard to noise restrictions are adhered to.

(2) <u>Minor Variation of Opening Hours at Toast, 18 Church Street, Falmouth</u>
The applicant reported a request for a minor variation in opening times from 1000 to 0100 to 1100 to 0200. He responded to Members questions.

It was proposed by Councillor Body, seconded by Councillor Mrs Brock and

RESOLVED that the Council raises no objection to the License application and noted that the venue was well run.
