### LSC184 CORNWALL COUNCIL LICENCES

Variation to Licence to extend opening hours. Toast, 18 Church Street, Falmouth  
The applicant explained that he wanted 1000 to 0200 Monday to Saturday and 1000 to 0000 hours Sunday. This was a minor variation to regularise the 0200 hours closing time. He responded to Members questions.

RESOLVED that subject to the approval of the Police Licensing Officer the Council does not object to Live Music, Recorded Music, Late Night Refreshment or Supply of Alcohol, Monday to Saturday 1000 to 0200 hours and Sunday 1000 to 0000 hours with non standard timings extending to 0100 hours on Bank Holiday Sundays, extending by 1 hour when BST commences, Christmas Day and Good Friday 2300 to 0030 hours and New Year's Eve 2300 to 0500 hours.

### LSC186 STREET TRADING

Street Trading Application, Swanpool Road, Falmouth

The applicant advised that he wished to trade selling ice creams, ice lollies and cold drinks on Swanpool Road from 1000 hours to 2100 hours May 2017 to December 2017. He responded to Members questions.

It was proposed by Councillor Mrs Minson, seconded by Councillor Bonney and

RESOLVED that the Council does not support the application as it would cause issues in regards to highway safety and difficult kerbside access for patrons.

Some Members of the Committee felt a pitch nearby at Silverdale Road may be more suitable but this would be difficult for the applicant and was not favoured by all Committee Members.
