LCS274 CORNWALL COUNCIL STREET TRADING RENEWALS

Grant to Licence, Satellite Café Ltd, Unit D3-D5 Old Highways Depot, Tregonigge Industrial Estate, Falmouth

Alice Somerlad advised that she intended to operate a vegan café in the former Bickland Café that closed in October 2018. Open Monday to Saturday 0700 hours to 2300 hours and Sundays 0800 hours to 2300 hours, the intention was Monday to Sunday for breakfast and lunches, plus evenings at weekends. Sale of alcohol Monday to Sunday 1000 hours to 2300 hours. To include occasional plays, film, live music, recorded music and performance of dances. She responded to questions and advised she was an experienced premises licence holder in Falmouth.

The Chairman reported that the Police Licensing Officer raised no objections but recommended a 2230 alcohol sale cessation to allow drinking up time. He noted it was outside the Cumulative Impact Zone and that competition with other premises was not a licensing reason for refusal.

It was proposed by Councillor Morgan, seconded by Councillor Saunby and

RESOLVED that subject to the recommendations of the Police Licensing Officer including no alcohol sales after 2230 hours then the Council raises no objection to the application.

A MOTION by Councillor Bonney that the Council objects to the application was not seconded.

There being no further business to transact the Chairman declared the Meeting closed at 5.50pm.
