In 2020 your Council will continue to provide the quality and award winning services that you advised us you want. We continue to change and adapt to deliver services in better and innovative ways. This has been recognised in a recent independent review which identified that we 'engage well with our community' and have 'impressive ways of partnership working', with 'councillors and staff clearly committed to the place and enthusiastic about the council'. The review has also provided us with some opportunities regarding long-term strategic planning, use of financial reserves and organisational review.

We shall continue to focus on environmental improvements and are working with Cornwall Council to devolve further parks and green spaces to local control to enable a better standard of maintenance and to develop a greater breadth of biodiversity thereon. We are engaging with the Making Space for Nature initiative and our other community partners such as Plastic Free Falmouth, as well as undertaking an organisational carbon and sustainability audit and action plan.

Cultural services remains embedded in our service delivery and in terms of projects the exciting skatepark development at Dracaena is progressing and following the successful provision of the community stage at Kimberley Park we are adding to that by creating community radio studios and café in the lodge. We are progressing the place shaping projects for the town centre arising from the neighbourhood plan. The neighbourhood plan will shortly be available for you to vote on and if adopted will form part of the policies that are applied to local planning applications and direct environment and green space sustainability and addition to 2030. We are also to develop a new cemetery extension at Bickland Water Road and will be updating our websites so that we are even more accessible.

We will provide the range of quality community events you are now used to and will support and lobby for community and traders in continuing uncertain economic times. Over the page is a breakdown of our budget and spending plans. We would love to hear from you, and we are here to assist you if you need us to. Your local councillors details are listed below.
