Dear Resident

2020 was a challenging year that we are sure we would all like to put behind us. The Council was obliged to undertake significant unexpected expenditure in order to best protect our community from the see-saw of Covid-19 pandemic lockdowns and recovery periods in between. We were also able to react to our residents' requests that we take steps to ensure Princess Pavilion and Gyllyngdune Gardens could be reopened after eight months closure and that they should remain in public ownership through an asset transfer from Cornwall Council. These measures have placed a drain on the Town Council's reserve levels which we are required and have committed to replenish to the Local Authority set level standards. Staff and councillors have worked tremendously hard to see us through the year and we thank them for that.

In 2020, the Council was also subject to an independent Local Authority Peer Review. Their findings indicate that Falmouth has a proactive council that engages well with residents and community partners and has a strong commitment to place and to our community and particularly with our young people through the Youth team working out of the Dracaena Centre. The Review also identified some opportunities for improvement, chief of which was the suggestion that we set a four year, costed, strategic plan to deliver council services, the aspirations set out in the Neighbourhood Development Plan and the sustainable measures needed to address climate change.

In 2021, the Council is due to take responsibility for more of our parks and green spaces as well as enhancing the 'Green Corridor' that runs from Bickland down through Tregoniggie Woods to Swanpool. Our emphasis will be on a better standard of maintenance, increased volunteering opportunities, improved accessibility and the introduction of a greater breadth of biodiversity. In addition to the major investment in Princess Pavilion and Gyllyngdune gardens we are exploring options for the conversion of Kimberley Park Lodge, raising funds to deliver the new Skatepark at Dracaena, developing a new cemetery for Falmouth at Bickland and delivering a fully-funded restoration project in the historic Jewish Cemetery and Dissenters' Burying Ground aka Ponsharden Cemeteries. The Town team will deliver the usual wide range of quality community events that we are used to (Covid-19 permitting), including the prestigious Tall-ships event in August .

Over the page is a breakdown of our budget and spending plans. If you want to hear more about our plans or our Peer Review we would love to hear from you, and we are here to assist you if you need us. Your local councillors details are listed over. These will change following the elections in May 2021.
